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Joseph Root is an economic theorist who works on Market and Mechanism Design, Microeconomic Theory, and Behavioral Economics. His dissertation, “Market Design Under Constraints,” studies how social and technological constraints limit the ways in which resources can be effectively distributed among individuals whose preferences are their own private information. His research focuses on identifying unifying mathematical features for these problems in order to increase the scope of applications for market design. Joseph earned his Ph.D. in Economics and M.A. in Mathematics from the University of California, Berkeley in 2020. He will join the department of Economics at the University of Chicago as an Assistant Professor in Fall 2021.
